Spanish utility Iberdrola is leading a microalgae technology project the Ministry of Science has selected in its sixth call for projects, ADP News reports. The initiative, requiring a 20 million euro investment, will develop new microalgae-based energy technologies. Iberdrola will work together with fifteen companies, including Repsol, as well as twenty-five research centres in ten Spanish autonomous regions and will work on selecting, cultivating and recovering microalgae for carbon capture and biofuel production from 2010 to 2013.
